Ajiki's early education in oil painting has a strong influence on his work, and is evident in his

sensitivity to color and design. He is unique in his vast range of shapes and styles,

although it is his use of salt-glazes that set him apart. Ajiki's artistic achievements are

exemplified in his basara series, which has received great acclaim; his work is opulent and

lavish, yet refined as shown in the richly colored checkerboard patterns on his faceted

teabowls.

In 1987, Ajiki won the prestigious Grand Prize at the Modern Tea Forms Exhibition of the

Tanabe Museum of Art for a basara teabowl, which was later acquired by Metropolitan

Museum of Art. His works can be found in the numerous public and private collections in

Japan and internationally.
